

Agenda for Midterm Chat: Meeting with Class

1. Introduction by Facilitator
The CTLT Facilitator will introduce him/herself, explain the purpose of the Midterm Chat, provide an overview of the Midterm Chat Process, and list the questions the students will be addressing. (Approx. 3 minutes)
2. Individual Response to Questions (in writing)
Students will write in response to each of the [Midterm Chat Questions](#). (Approx. 10 minutes)
3. Small Group Consideration of Questions
Students will meet in small groups (3-4 students/group) and try to reach some kind of consensual response to each of the questions. One student should be the recorder for the group, keeping a [written record](#) of the group's discussion. (Approx 15 minutes)
4. Whole Group "Debriefing"
The facilitator will lead a "debriefing" of the groups, including
 - getting responses to each question from each group
 - checking for consensus among groups
 - asking for clarification when necessary(Approx. 15 minutes)
